Advanced Infrastructure Liaison Officer (ILO) May 29, 2017 | 0800 - 1700 HOURS San Diego, CA

Course Description:

The ILO Advanced course introduces risk management to attendees through the use of a traditional risk equation to support assessments of security at a facility or organization. The course uses an approach that focuses on vulnerabilities, consequences, and threat capabilities of potential adversaries. From this perspective, participants learn methods to identify critical assets and potential vulnerabilities that may impact the organization, best practices to conduct a vulnerability assessment and reduce vulnerabilities, and approaches to reduce consequences during a crisis and enhance overall resiliency of the organization.

- Consequence Management
- Identifying Critical Assets
- Vulnerability Assessments
- Policies, Plans, and Procedures
